Seasonal Sights of Hokkaido (from May till October)

In May, melting icicles signal the arrival of spring with verdure bursting into life and welcoming blooming Cherry blossoms, Moss Phlox, Tulips. The sight of waterfalls are also most stunning during this period.



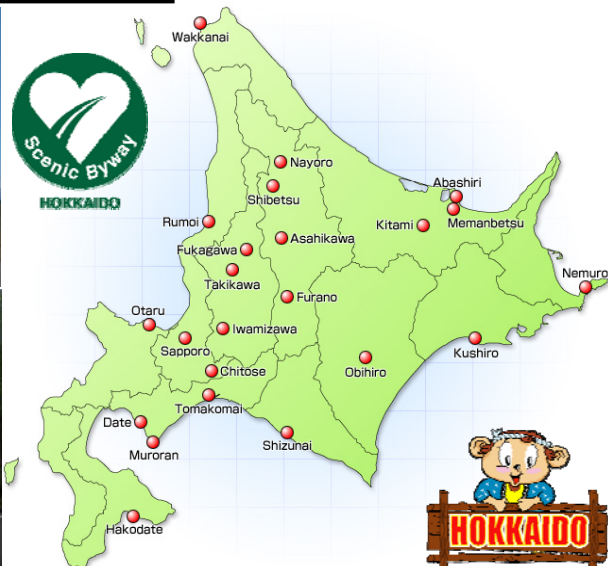
Come June, the sky turns blue, the weather cool and spring flowers bloom and wildlife begin to appear. Sightings of wild bear, Hokkaido red foxes and Ezo deer are common in Shiretoko World Natural Heritage site.



From July to August come hot sunny days and brilliant flowers paint the landscape with waves of multi-colors; the aromatic smell of Lavender filled the air while acres of land erupt in a blaze of bright yellow, as sunflowers make their presence known.



Spectacular fall foliage and spawning salmon can be seen from September to October with abundant autumn fruits ripe for harvesting before the coming of the cold winter months.

DAY 00 (28 May) THU — CHITOSE TO ASAHIKAWA

DAY 01 (29 May) FRI — CHITOSE TO ASAHIKAWA

Nothing has the ability to expand your horizons quite like a springtime outing on the open road and embark on a journey of self-discovery. Picking up the car today, we'll be driving through the pastoral landscapes of Furano & Biei, heading to Asahikawa, the second largest city after Sapporo for a night stay.

Right next to the Anpanman store is the Furano Jam Factory, where you can find over 40 varieties of delicious homemade jam made from jus about every fruit and vegetable. With pieces of bread provided, you will be able sample the various varieties available. Although there are a number of large flower farms dotting the landscape of Furano and Biei, this may not really be the best time to visit them as most of the fields are still being prepared for planting. However, at Farm Tomita you may find rows of blooming Tulips and in small green house Lavender blooms throughout the year. The Trick Art Museum may make an interesting stop as where a number of work of Art make clever use of distortion and imagery to surprise visitors. Ramen lovers should make a trip to Asahikawa Ramen Village where the sound of slurping can be heard emanating from the 8 renowned local stalls. (*Asahikawa Shoyu Ramen has the reputation of being the finest ramen in Japan*)

DAY 02 (30 May) SAT — ASAHIKAWA TO ABASHIRI

May is one of the best season to visit the eastern part of Hokkaido as the flowers of May, Moss Phlox and Tulip, give added colors to the landscapes of Hokkaido. The journey today will bring you across mountain to the stunning Moss Phlox carpeted hills of Takinoue Park and toward the Sea of Okhotsk where approximately 1.2 million stalks of multi-colors tulips vividly bloom in the 7 ha Kamiyubetsu Tulip Park. With people posing and cameras snapping away, these 2 sites can bring forth the soft spot, flower loving nature in everyone of us. Those with children may also want to consider visiting the Okhotsk Drift Ice Museum, an interesting facility with blocks of actual drift ice on displayed and housed in a room at -15degree temperature. While history buff should consider dropping by the Abashiri Prison Museum, an actual prison turned into a museum to showcase the live of hardcore convicts behind the wall. Staying in the Hokuten no Oka, a hot spring resort hotel, you'll get the chance to finally dip your body into the minerals rich bath of Hokkaido's hot spring and feel your body relaxed and your mind refreshed in the chilly spring's evening.

DAY 03 (31 May) SUN — ABASHIRI TO AKAN

It is hard not to get lost in thoughts when you drive through amazing and very natural sceneries with a few town but no major cities, with magnificent mountains, picturesque lakes and the occasional sightings of wild animals. It is a sort of awakening with a subtle message of how beautiful nature can be when efforts are taken to preserve it. The drive toward Akan today will allow you to appreciate such wonders and more. Ascending and descending curving mountain roads to reach the hot spring town of Akan, you'll be pleasantly surprised to find that this charming town actively support the preservation and promotion of the aboriginal (Ainu) cultures. The main street of the town is lined on both sides with folk art stores and restaurants, and at the Onne Chise, visitors can watch ancient Ainu dance and listen to performances of the traditional Ainu Jew's harp.

DAY 04 (01 Jun) MON — AKAN

The true charm of the elegant Akan Tsuruga Hotel is its diversity of hot spring baths. There are a number of bath pools with different mineral contents including a few outdoor baths on its 8th floor overlooking Lake Akan and another in its basement just beside the Lake Akan. Soaking in such pleasant environment give you a sense of peace and serenity, leaving all worries till a better time. The waterfront walk, which spans along Lake Akan is always an excellent way to start off the morning. After a cup of coffee, you may want to set off to admire the scenery and lavish in the quietness of the town except for the sound of the breaking waves.

DAY 05 (02 Jun, Tue) AKAN TO TOKACHIGAWA

Tokachi is the agricultural kingdom and a major food producing area. The high productivity of Tokachi's agriculture has been achieved by a combination of fertile land, large-scale farming and mechanization. The total area of cultivated land is approximately 250,000 hectares with an approximate of 6,700 farms dotting the landscape. Toward Tokachi are forests and lakes which remain in their primeval state and people living off vast farmland in this sparsely populated area. Taking the route to Tokachi today is like taking a route leading to its unknown charms which leads you to fall back on the hackneyed expression "it's not about the destination; it's the journey". At Tokachigawa hot spring resort, the "Moor Hot Spring" is unique to Hokkaido. The waters is highly osmotic and gentle on the skin, milder and richer in natural moisturizers than ordinary hot springs, smoothing and moisturizing the skin, making Tokachigawa hot spring a famous natural splendors "hot spring for beauty".

DAY 06 (03 Jun, Wed) TOKACHIGAWA TO SAPPORO

Otaru, a city best known for its glassware, musical boxes and historical building giving visitors a sense of nostalgia when visiting. Driving to Otaru today, you can stop by for a visit to some of its renowned places like the tourist draws of **Otaru Canal**, **Music Box Hall** and **Kitaichi Glass** and spend some time strolling Sakaimachi streets, lined with numerous specialty gifts shops. Also known for its fresh seafood, with numerous sushi stalls, Otaru is where you can find for some of the best sushi in Hokkaido. Proceeding to Sapporo in the evening, you may want to check-in to your hotel first and before going out to see some of its sights and have dinner in one of its many highly acclaimed restaurants. If you are a crab lover, Sapporo is definitely the place to be as there are a number of specialty crab restaurants serving some of the most delicious crab dishes one can find.
