**Seasonal Sights of Hokkaido (from May till October)**

In May, melting icicles signal the arrival of spring with verdure bursting into life and welcoming blooming Cherry blossoms, Moss Phlox, Tulips. The sight of waterfalls are also most stunning during this period.



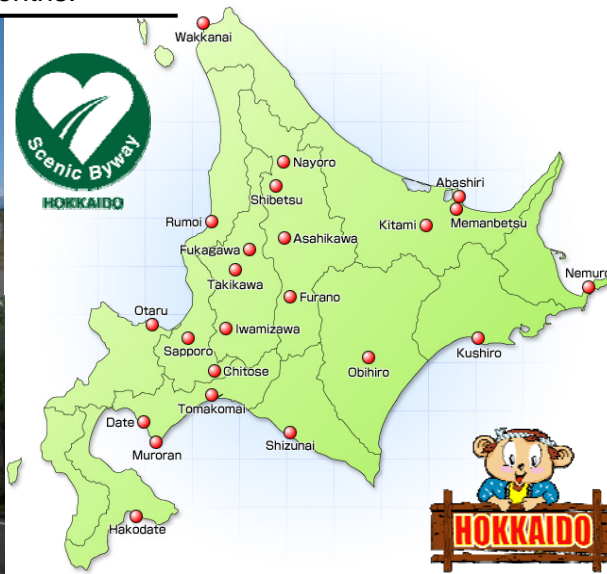
Come June, the sky turns blue, the weather cool and spring flowers bloom and wildlife begin to appear. Sightings of wild bear, Hokkaido red foxes and Ezo deer are common in Shiretoko World Natural Heritage site.



From July to August come hot sunny days and brilliant flowers paint the landscape with waves of multi-colors; the aromatic smell of Lavender filled the air while acres of land erupt in a blaze of bright yellow, as sunflowers make their presence known.



Spectacular fall foliage and spawning salmon can be seen from September to October with abundant autumn fruits ripe for harvesting before the coming of the cold winter months.



Not everyone would consider venturing into the highlands which, once you've seen what they have to offer, you'll be glad you did! This is a stunning area where pure nature means pure enjoyment. 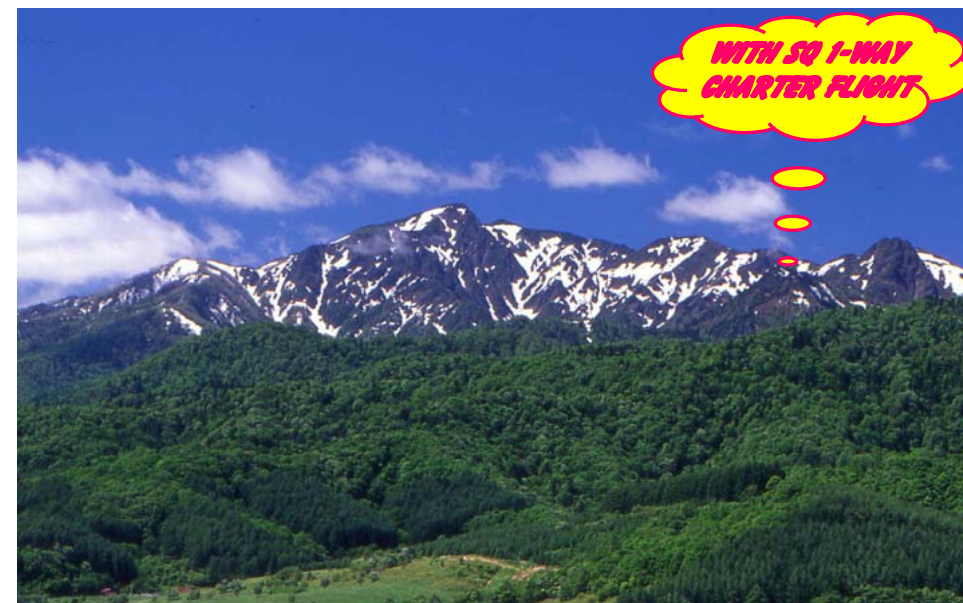

## DAY 00 (04 Jun) THU — SINGAPORE TO CHITOSE

Assemble at the Singapore Changi Airport for your direct flight to Hokkaido.

## DAY 01 (05 Jun) FRI — SINGAPORE TO CHITOSE TO NOBORIBETSU

Arriving in the Chitose Airport, proceed to pick up your car. After a familiarization of the GPS navigation system, we will take a scenic route through Lake Shikotsu, a 32,000 year old caldera lake that seldom freezes even in winter temperatures of -5°C. Forest 276 is a road station that houses fast food restaurants and souvenir shops. Ainu are the indigenous people of Hokkaido and if you are interested in learning more about them, you can go to the Shiraoi Ainu Village. Noboribetsu is a well-known hot spring town where people visit for its healing water and scenic attractions.

## DAY 02 (06 Jun) SAT — NOBORIBETSU TO HAKODATE

Hakodate City is the southern gateway to Hokkaido with an excellent port. It is one of the first cities in Japan to be opened to international trade. Owing to the number of unique historical sites and buildings, fresh, abundant seafood and hot springs, Hakodate boasts of about 5 million visitors annually. At Cape Chikyu, the earth seems to fall into the Pacific Ocean, and beyond the land, the vast ocean stretch on, seemingly endlessly.

## DAY 03 (07 Jun) SUN — HAKODATE

Even though all the historical buildings in Hakodate have their own unique tales to tell, it is hard not to be charmed by how they seem to complement one another perfectly. Foreign influence decades ago had left their marks on the architecture and layout of the city, which can be most appreciated in the Motomachi area.

Traveling back to Yunokawa, your eyes will definitely be drawn to the glowing lights of squid-catching boats on the Tsugaru Strait. Hovering above the sea surface, it will seem like the stars have fallen onto the water.

## DAY 04 (08 Jun) MON — HAKODATE TO RUSUTSU

After an early morning visit to the Hakodate Morning Market where mouth-watering seafood tantalizes the taste buds, you can go to the Toya National Park enroute to Rusutsu. Stopping by Showa Shinzan to take the ropeway up Mt Usu is a must to see the panoramic view of Lake Toya and the world down below.

## DAY 05 (09 Jun) TUE— RUSUTSU TO OTARU

After departing from Rusutsu, ascend the curving roads of the Niseko Panorama Line to immerse yourself in splendid sights of lakes and marshes, rugged and picturesque coasts. Continuing on to Otaru, you will be greeted with a city of nostalgic charm. An economic hub from the Meiji to early Showa period, Otaru is adorned with Victorian gas lamps lining cobbled stone streets, and stone-built warehouses restored as shops. During the day Otaru is a hive of activity, but as night falls and gas lamps flicker to life, this city quietens down to a beautiful romantic town.

## DAY 06 (10 Jun) WED — OTARU TO SAPPORO

Back in Sapporo, do not be surprised to find yourself slowing behind red tail lights as it is home to a population of about 1.9 million people sharing an area of about 1,100 square kilometers. With such a big population, finding a good place to eat will never be a problem. Perhaps the only problem will be you do not know which one to choose from. Japanese, Korean, Chinese, Italian, and even Singaporean (Kopitiam food court in Tanokikoji Shopping Alley) food can be found concentrated in the city.

Many structures and buildings in Sapporo had seen this city through the ebbs and flows of time. From the Old Hokkaido Government Building to the Clock Tower, there are many pockets of history that can be found in this modern city still.

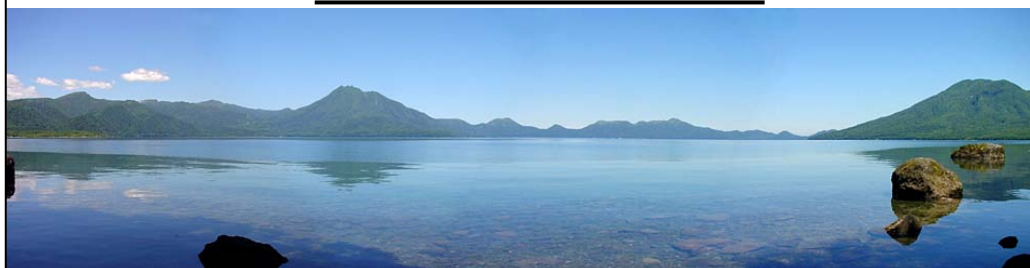
