Tour Itinerary (09:00 ~ 17:00)

We'll visit the **Kouka district** with its mountains and wealth of nature, located to the south of Lake Biwa, the biggest lake in Japan. First, we'll visit the beautiful **Miho Museum**, a world-famous museum, designed in the image of "Shangri-la", by I. M. Pei, who also designed the "Glass pyramid" of the Louvre in Paris. On the way to Miho Museum, we'll enjoy a pretty traditional Japanese countryside view. After enjoying the wonders of the Miho Museum, we'll drive on a cute, small country road into the **Asamiya district**, which is a famous tea plantation area featuring a whole mountain covered with beautiful tea fields. For lunchtime, we'll enjoy **Soba (buckwheat noodle)** in a traditional Japanese country style restaurant with a traditional Japanese in-floor hearth. In the afternoon, we'll experience **picking tea leaves** and **making our own Japanese black tea**, instructed by a teashop owner whose family has been in the tea business in the area for many generations. You can take fresh tea home as a souvenir.
